PROCUREMENT OF CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR THE INVESTIGATION, DESIGN, INSTALLATION AND COMMISSIONING OF CHLORINATION FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT FOR WATER SUPPLY TREATMENT SYSTEMS AND PROVISION OF TRAINING IN SAMOA



The Samoa Water Authority (SWA) intends to apply funds received through the Government of Samoa to procure Consultancy Services for the “Investigation, Design, Installation and Commissioning of Chlorination Facilities and Equipment for Water Supply Treatment Systems and Provision of Training in Samoa”.

The assignment will be undertaken in two phases and the consultant is expected to provide approximately 4 months total input.

The purpose of the assignment is to upgrade and extend existing chlorination facilities within SWA supply systems to ensure that SWA can maintain more effectively the Samoa National Drinking Water Standard. This will require the replacement of buildings where required and the rehabilitation / replacement of existing equipment or the total revamp in design of the chlorination facilities and equipment.

Quotations are invited from suitably qualified local or international Firms to undertake this assignment.
